


WELCOME TO The Tradition

It's easy to imagine the reaction of the skiers who first gazed out onto the awe-inspiring Sawtooth Range. Sun Valley is a downhill paradise found, with more than 3,400 vertical feet and over 2,000 acres of varied terrain. In fact, Sun Valley offers something special to skiers and boarders of all ages and skill levels on not just one mountain, but two.

Bald Mountain

Bald Mountain features the consistency of pitch, lack of lift lines, and variety of terrain that have earned it a reputation as one of the world's finest ski mountains. A total of 13 chairlifts and 65 varied runs await skiers and boarders on both sides of Baldy. You can literally descend top to bottom over perfect slopes with no flats—a nonstop flight guaranteed to leave you breathless. Adding to the Baldy adventure this season will be themed Adventure Trails for kids and 30 acres of glade ski/boarding terrain for all.

Dollar Mountain

Dollar Mountain is the perfect place to get acclimated to downhill sports and features two new high-speed quad lifts, a tubing hill, a full-featured terrain park with 20 new rails and super pipe, and the Wundercarpet, which effortlessly whisks children of all ages up the hill.

To complete an incomparable experience, Sun Valley's ski and snowboard school features over 240 PSIA-certified instructors to help you hone your alpine, snowboard, telemark, or Nordic skills. Carol's Dollar Mountain Lodge


Carol's Dollar Mountain Lodge provides an unparalleled family vacation experience at the base of our original hill. The 26,000-square-foot family center is home to our children's ski and snowboard school, equipment rental and repair, ski storage lockers, and shopping.

Roundhouse

And over on Baldy, midway up the River Run side (now accessible to skiers and non-skiers alike via our new gondola), you'll find Sun Valley's historic Roundhouse. It features sit-down service around a four-sided fireplace and a world-class wine list. Buy a "foot traffic" pass and meet your friends for lunch.

Whether you're here for relaxation or exhilaration, you'll find plenty to do (or not do) in Sun Valley. For those who can't get enough winter sports, there's the Sun Valley Ice Rink and our renowned Nordic and Snowshoe Center—providing access to over 25 miles of manicured and marked trails. (A day on the mountain can easily be exchanged for a cross-country trek through glistening meadows with our Lift Ticket Exchange Program.)

Or trade your parka for a swimsuit and enjoy a dip in one of our outdoor swimming pools (heated to 102 degrees in winter) or a relaxing spa visit. Kids of all ages will enjoy a break at our own cozy bowling alley. Stroll the village to browse quaint shops filled with fine art, jewelry, and fashion. The authentic Western allure of downtown Ketchum is minutes away and filled with bars, dining options, and spots overflowing with local color.

One more tip: No Sun Valley visit is complete without taking the sleigh ride to Trail Creek Cabin—a timeless winter treat transporting you to a sumptuous dinner in a historic mountain cabin built in 1937.



Taking care of you without compromise is also a tradition around here.



By Air
